Terms of Business

It is agreed that the terms set out in this booking form is the total agreement made between the parties and that no variation or modification of this contract shall be effective unless agreed by both parties in writing. By signing the wedding booking form, the bride & groom and/or their authorised agents, assign PNPimage / Peter Noyce Photography exclusive rights to photograph the wedding outlined on the booking form.

Booking A non-refundable booking fee of 10% is required at the time of booking. Your date is reserved upon payment of this fee plus receipt of this signed contract. The balance will be invoiced three months prior to your wedding for payment no later than two weeks before your wedding day.

Cancellation The Client may cancel this contract at any time by giving written notice to PNPimage / Peter Noyce Photography. The full fee is payable if notice of cancellation is received less than twelve weeks prior to the ceremony. If the Photographer is forced to cancel the agreement then any fees and deposits will be reimbursed in full to the client.

License PNPimage / Peter Noyce Photography shall be granted artistic license in relation to the poses photographed and the locations used. The Photographers judgment regarding the locations, poses and number of images taken shall be deemed correct. Every effort will be made to take all the photographs as discussed prior to the wedding but due to the vagaries of the weather and the willingness of subjects it may not be possible to capture all the images requested. No responsibility is accepted for any specific individuals missing from group shots, for whatever reason.

Copyright In accordance with The Copyright, Design and Patents Act 1988 The copyright of all photographs taken by PNPimage / Peter Noyce Photography remains our sole property. We may, at our discretion, use these photographs in whole or in part for exhibition or display or publication (Web, Print, CD, DVD, Broadcast). Should you purchase high resolution images you also purchase the licence to reproduce those images for personal use in perpetuity.

Web Display Images of your wedding will remain viewable via your client area for 12 months.

Inclusive Album You will receive a proof DVD of all of the images of your wedding normally within 2-3 weeks. You should make your selection of images for any inclusive album within 6 months. After 12 months a small additional charge may apply.

Colour reproduction and stability The photographs will provide a pleasing colour balance based upon the flesh tone but due to limitations of photographic dyes no guarantee of exact colour match or resistance to fade can be given. All photographic sizes are nominal.

Re-orders All re-orders shall be treated as an extension of this contract and no responsibility for errors will be accepted unless orders are given in writing. Prices will be those prevailing at the time of order. No re-orders will be processed unless payment is received in full at the time of ordering. Prices will be those prevailing at the time of order.

Limitation of Liability In the unlikely event of a total photographic failure or cancellation of this contract by either party or in any other circumstance the liability of one party to the other shall be limited to the total value of the contract. Neither party shall be liable for indirect or consequential loss.

The Photographer On occasions and without notice, it may be necessary for the photographer originally specified to be substituted by another photographer, (e.g. due to ill health).

Force majeure The due performance of this contract is subject to alteration or cancellation by either party owing to any cause beyond their control.

Sole rights The Client(s) gives sole photography rights (stills) to Peter Noyce Photography for the purpose of resale or publication. We have no objection to family and friends taking pictures.

Data Protection Act: Client details are held on our internal database, and are not passed on to any third party without permission of client. Client details will be removed on request.

Complaints Any complaints should be raised by the Client with the Photographer, in writing, within 21 days of first becoming aware of the matter to be complained of and in any event within 21 days of receipt of the images.

English Law The contract shall be deemed to be a contract made in England and shall in all respects be governed by and construed in accordance with English Law.
